AN INTERIM STATEMENT

On November 27, the Boulder Valley School District Board Of Education met in a work session with the BVSD Superintendent, the President of the Boulder Valley Education Association, central office administrators, other educators including principals and teacher representatives, (34 participants) and 15 members of the public (including three students). The purpose of the meeting was to reach an initial agreement on the values statements that had been developed during the public listening session held on November 2-3, 2012.

The document that was used is on page 52 of the final report for the public listening session. It is titled "THE VALUES WE SUPPORT." This document is selected because it concisely expresses the desires of the public and the educators who attended. This document is referred to as an "interim" set of values because the public will have an opportunity to review it and make further suggestions. This was stated in the purpose of the public listening session and is repeated below:

"The information gathered in this workshop will significantly influence the later drafting of proposed board goals by the school board and superintendent this fall. Once drafted, those proposed goals will be made available for public discussion and comment - both online or in person - prior to the school board taking formal action to consider the proposed long term goals this winter."

The statements that were used to develop agreement are the bolded headings at the beginning of each set of values.

A working document on pages 2-3 was created using these bolded headings. The work session participants then engaged in determining if there was any disagreement with each of the value statements. Any expressed disagreement was then resolved through often lengthy discussions. The intent was to get as close to a consensus agreement as possible, while retaining the original intent of the public.

If a values statement of the public needed additional explanatory information, or if it could be expressed in a way that reflected the concerns of the work session participants, the adapted statement was then shown in red.

The interim document on page 4 indicates the agreements reached on the values statements. After all statements have been reviewed it was determined that they would be presented for public review.
