

## About Des Moines' Neighborhood Revitalization Program

The Revitalize Des Moines MindMixer site is an input tool for the City of Des Moines' Neighborhood Revitalization Program. The Program is a public/private partnership to stabilize and enhance Des Moines' neighborhoods. Residents and stakeholders from selected neighborhoods work with City staff to create and implement a Neighborhood Plan. The plans identify goals, strategies and action steps for improving the quality of life in a neighborhood. Most plans focus on physical improvements to housing, parks, trails and open space, infrastructure, and commercial areas. Some look at other issues like crime and safety or neighborhood engagement. Participation in the program also provides access to lending through the Neighborhood Finance Corporation.

Beginning in 2012, eight neighborhoods are actively participating in the Neighborhood Revitalization Program: Gray's Lake, Lower Beaver, Martin Luther King Jr. Park, River Bend, Beaverdale, Woodland Heights, Capitol East, and Capitol Park (a map is included in this document). While this site is primarily intended to gather input for these eight neighborhood plans, the "All Neighborhoods" category asks for your ideas on improving Des Moines' neighborhoods in general. Anyone who has ideas about how to make our neighborhoods better is invited to participate in the conversation.

## How can my neighborhood participate in the program?

Neighborhood associations apply for the Revitalization Program through a competitive application process. This round's selection was determined based on the types of issues and opportunities identified by the neighborhood, the availability of resources to meet those needs, the level of support demonstrated by members of the neighborhood, and the willingness of the neighborhood association to take on a leadership role.

For the first time, Charter neighborhoods were also invited to apply in 2011 under a pilot program. A Charter neighborhood has already completed and implemented a plan; however, many of these plans are now 15-20 years old. The five Charter neighborhoods -- River Bend, Beaverdale, Woodland Heights, Capitol East, and Capitol Park -- will be updating their original plan with new goals for the future. These neighborhoods will work with City staff as well as graduate students in planning from Iowa State University. River Bend is taking on a special, neighborhood-led planning process.


The next round of applications for the Neighborhood Revitalization Program is expected to open sometime in 2014.
