They Composted!



They Upgraded Their Lighting!



Shoe Inn Boutique began composting tissue paper from shoe boxes and other packaging materials and found that their waste stream was reduced by 75%. Compost is sent to the Summit County commercial compost facility and turned into soil for local sale and use. Diversion rate with composting: 75%

Shoe Inn Boutique replaced 37 inefficient halogen bulbs with energy efficient LED bulbs. They also upgraded eight fluorescent lamps to a more efficient T8 model. Half of the cost of materials was covered by the Frisco Clean Track program. "In the summer, the new LED lights don't make indoor temperatures unbearably hot. The display area is brighter and our summer electricity bills have been cut in half." said Shoe Inn co-owner Shannon Murray. Energy savings: 6181 kWh and \$620 annually
