

Conceptual Master Plan: Dog Exercise Area

Waukegan Savanna Forest Preserve

The "Conceptual Master Plan" for Waukegan Savanna Forest Preserve was approved in 2010. The master plan includes a 40-acre off-leash DOG EXERCISE AREA to serve the northeast area of Lake County. As proposed in the Approved Master Plan, the Dog Exercise Area would include a crushed-stone loop trail loop, mowed-grass trails, a small-dog pen, an 80-car parking lot, toilets and a person-canine drinking fountain. This will be a "dry" Dog Exercise Area with no open water (pond or creek).

The proposed plan is conceptual and will be refined through further design development. There is the potential to modify some of the proposed elements through this process. This drawing focuses on the Dog Exercise Area and does not illustrate the approved master plan in its entirety.
