






Strong Polices Emerge from Active Community Dialogue



Pedestrian Suitability Index – Demand Analysis






Supply: Existing Facilities

Types of Solutions Expected from the Plan

Santa Monica Pedestrian Action Plan

HIGH DEMAND / LOW SUPPLY

Invest in infrastructure to meet demand; high investment priority

HIGH DEMAND / HIGH SUPPLY

Innovative design treatments, closure of key gaps; high investment priority

Model-Based Recommendations

Pedestrian encouragement programs; high investment priority

LOW DEMAND / HIGH SUPPLY

Basic infrastructure improvements; low investment priority
