



McGaugh Pool History

The Seal Beach Community Pool was built in 1964 on the McGaugh Campus at 1698 Bolsa Avenue. The pool is 25 yards in length and has six lanes for lap swimming. Users also enjoy deep water aerobics, swim team practice, swim classes, recreation swim, junior lifeguard prep classes and water polo.

In May 2010 the City performed repairs on the pool to fix a water leak that was causing the pool to lose large quantities of water. The City also made several other repairs to increase the facility's useful life and bring the facility into compliance with several building code updates.

The City of Seal Beach is now seeking to find a location where a new aquatics center can be built. As part of the Swim Seal Beach effort, a site for a new facility will be found and master planned.
